From the Immersion Director:

When I interact with people who are unfamiliar with immersion education, I am often asked how it is possible for children to learn academic concepts at the same time they are learning a new language. I briefly explain that our immersion teachers are experts at something called counterbalanced instruction. This is basically a technical way of saying that our teachers artfully dance between teaching content and teaching language concepts. We know that language is best learned within a meaningful context; therefore, while teaching math (or science or any other subject) our teachers will have both content and language goals. They will be teaching multiplication but will quickly side step to highlight a language feature that came through in the instructions or the story problem. While teaching social studies, they might ask the students to circle four past tense verbs in the text about the civil war. It is truly a beautiful thing to watch how our immersion teachers weave counterbalanced instruction into all of their teaching!
