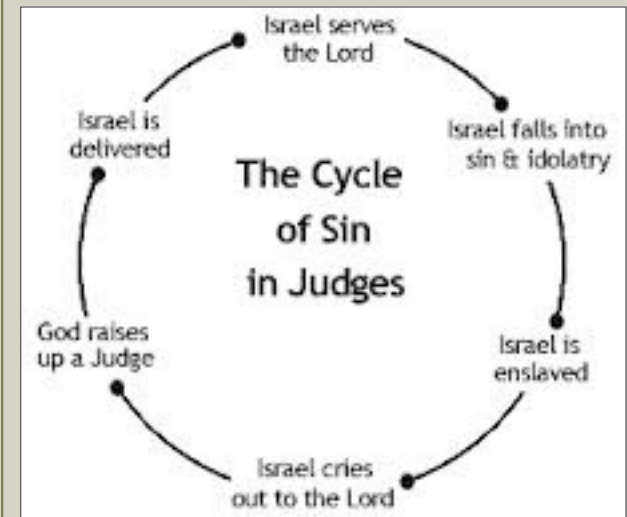


Psalm 135:13-18
