
Laos Persecution

Laos Persecution:

Laos is ranked as **29** in a world watch list for countries with the worst Christian Persecution. Christians refuse to participate in Buddhism, and it results in death if they do not cooperate, which many don't. Anything other than Buddhism and Animism is considered a dangerous threat in Laos.

Laos Persecution:

In 2011 **7,985** bibles/scripture were delivered to Laos. In 2012 **20,743** bibles/scripture were delivered to Laos.

Laos Persecution:

Laos closed many churches starting on the countryside due to possible persecution. Around 58 churches have been closed in the last 18 months. Churches in Laos, are watched very carefully by the government.

Laos Persecution:

Since 1975, freedom of opinion is not allowed. Religious activity and talk, all must be run past the government before you actually start doing anything that is religious.

Laos Persecution:

Christians are harassed, evicted from their homes, relocated, denied in education, arrested and forced to deny their faith.

Laos Persecution:

Laos population is 7.1 million, and only 192,000 of them are Christians.
